Where: Lafayette Square Park, Washington, DC (located directly across from White House, at 16 Street and H Street, NW)

The wild mustangs and burros of the West are under siege. Unfortunately, the agency entrusted to protect them, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), is to blame.

Secretary of the Interior Ken Salazar and the BLM have declared war on these animals, savagely rounding them up by the tens of thousands. Those mustangs and burros who survive the roundups are forced to spend the rest of their lives in BLM “holding pens,” or worse yet, wind up in butchered in slaughterhouses.

We need you to stand with us and demand the BLM end to these roundups. After the press conference and rally, we will march to the Department of the Interior building to hand deliver a letter to Secretary Salazar.
