## INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

Please read completely.

- The recommended age for spay/neutering is **2 - 6 months** of age. Female animals should be spayed before their first heat (estrus cycle). They do not need to have a litter before spaying.
- Before** ordering a Friends of Animals spay/neuter certificate, please call the veterinarian of your choice from the "Participating Veterinarian" list and confirm his/her continued participation in the Friends of Animals' spay/neuter program. Inform the veterinarian that you intend to use a Friends of Animals' spay/neuter certificate. Ask any questions you may have regarding the procedure, what is required, and if there are any additional fees.
- DO NOT MAKE AN APPOINTMENT with the veterinarian UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE FRIENDS OF ANIMALS CERTIFICATE. You must have the certificate to give to the veterinarian when the animal is admitted for spay/neutering.**
- The Friends of Animals' certificate covers the cost of a routine spay/neuter procedure including a cursory (not full) surgical pre-exam, anesthesia, surgical procedure, waste disposal, day of surgery post-operative care and pain relief, hospitalization as required, and stitch removal if necessary.
- Inoculations are the responsibility of the pet-owner and may be required by the veterinarian.**
- The veterinarian may charge the pet-owner additional fees for **non-routine** procedures, including but not limited to:
  - if required, blood work must be discounted to a rate of \$36 - \$65.
  - for dogs 50 lbs. and over, a fee of not more than \$1 per lb. over 50 lbs.
  - pre-diagnosed infections
  - animals in estrus (heat)
  - take home medication
  - full examination
  - undescended testicles
  - pregnancy
  - age (animal over 6 yrs.)

**Ask the veterinarian about any additional charges before the spay/neuter procedure is performed.** All services requested unrelated to a routine spay/neuter procedure are the responsibility of the pet owner.

Friends of Animals Certificates for cats are not valid if the cat is to be declawed. Cats need claws for protection and for their physical and mental well-being. **Declawing is painful, cruel and psychologically damaging.**

- Fill out the above form completely (including animal type and sex) and mail it with your payment to the address on the **blue** form.

- Certificate expires one (1) year after date of issue. Certificate may not be transferred or resold.**
- Friends of Animals will process your order and payment upon receipt and mail your certificate(s) within 7 business days. **The quickest way is to order via our website at [www.friendsofanimals.org](http://www.friendsofanimals.org) - it is sent via postal mail the next business day.**
- Refund Policy: Prior to expiration, return unused certificate to the FoA HQ address below. A \$20 service fee will be deducted for each certificate refunded. Lost or expired certificates are not refundable; no refunds made after one (1) year from date of issue.
- Reissue Policy: Return the unused certificate along with a \$10 service fee to the FoA HQ address below. No reissue on a lost certificate. Pet-owner must also pay the difference if rates have increased.
